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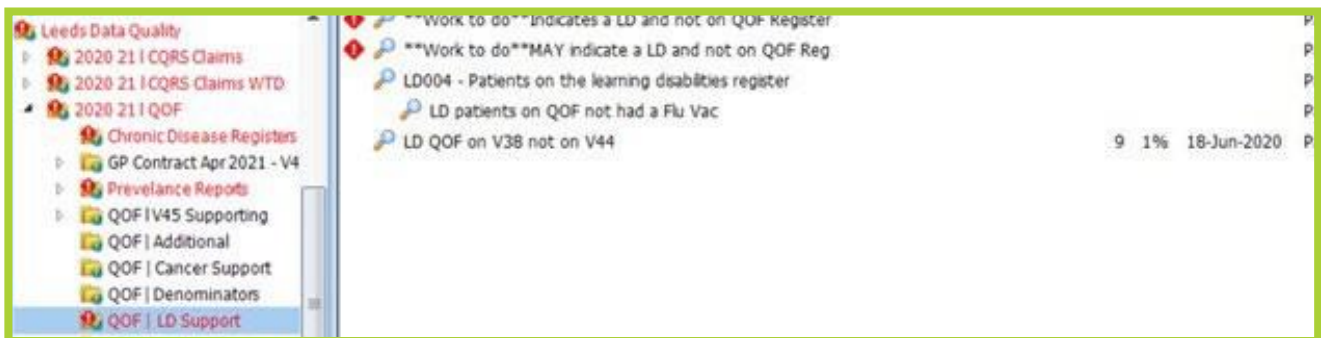
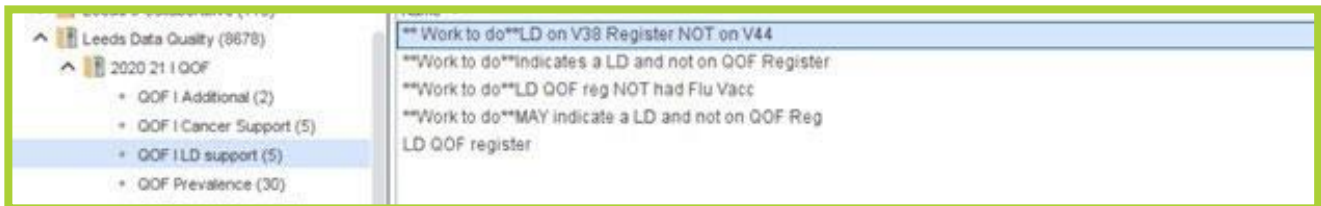
Supporting searches

These searches support in the coding of LD and help to identify those maybe coded incorrectly and not on LD registers.

Any patient that is identified as having a LD should be coded with:

On learning disability register (**416075005**) this code should be input using the date of the initial diagnosis.

(Please ensure this is not added as a new diagnosis with today's date)

Re coding errors

If you have already completed the 1st step of coding patients with the On Learning disabilities register and believe you have done this incorrectly.

Please run the below report to check if you have incorrectly coded any patient with a diagnosis of LD, when they already had a previous diagnosis code entered.

If this code was entered as part of the plan to ensure your LD patient was on all LD registers as above.

Please mark in error the code entered in 2019/20 unless the patient was correctly diagnosed for the first time in 2019/20.

If this was done in error, please add code On Learning Disabilities Register 416075005 on the same date as the initial diagnosis and remove the code entered in 2019/20.

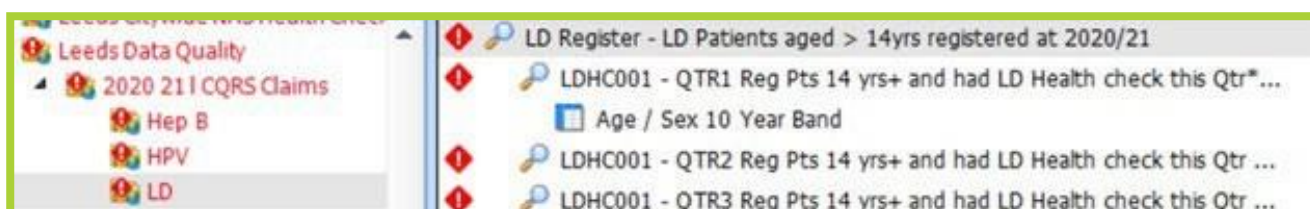
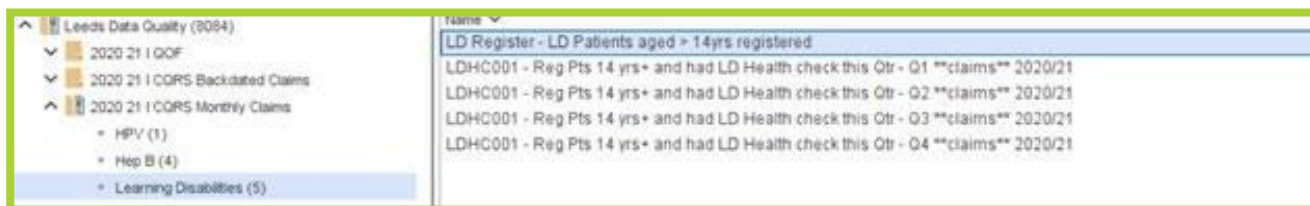
