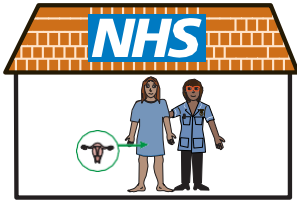

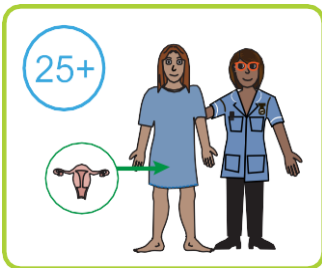

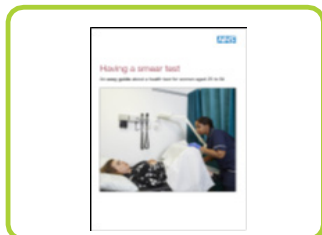

This is sometimes called a smear or a smear test.

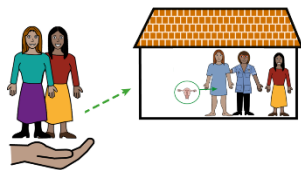
This is a routine appointment and is nothing to worry about.

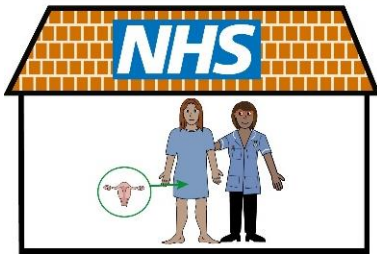

Reasonable Adjustments – Cervical Screening

cervical screening



A reasonable adjustment is a **small change** that can be made to make your **appointment easier** for you. **You can ask** for reasonable adjustments for your cervical screening appointment. Below are some examples. You can **speak to your GP practice** about **any reasonable adjustments** you need.

Reasonable Adjustment	How you can help me	Yes
	I need easy read documents.	
	I need information in Braille.	
	I need information in large print.	
	I need information in another language – if so what language?	
	I use British Sign Language (BSL)	
	I may need to visit before my appointment to feel comfortable in the environment.	
	I need a longer appointment.	
	I need time to take information in and answer questions	
	I would like to talk to the nurse about the screening test before making an appointment.	
	I find it difficult to wait for my appointment, I need to wait outside until you are ready to see me.	
	I need someone to come with me to my appointment.	
	Bright lights or loud noises may affect me.	
	I am sensitive to touch
